CCNSG Nationally Accredited Safety Passport – Renewal Scheme

1 day

Who should attend this course and why?

The renewal course is designed for all personnel who are in possession of a valid safety passport. The course will bring the candidate up to date with new legislation.

The CCNSG Safety Passport is often a pre-requisite for working on site in industries such as oil, gas, chemical, manufacturing, nuclear and energy sectors. The aim of the scheme is to ensure a basic knowledge of health and safety for all site personnel to enable them, after appropriate site induction, to work on site more safely with lower risk to themselves and others.

Course Pre-Requisites

The candidate will possess a valid CCNSG Safety Passport which is due to expire (within 3 months). If the Passport has expired, ECITB will allow up to 3 months from date of expiry for the renewal course to be attended.

The candidate **must** bring to the course:

- 2 passport photographs
- National Insurance Number/Passport

- Existing valid Safety Passport

Course Overview

The CCNSG National Course is a one day course to refresh the candidate on basic site safety.

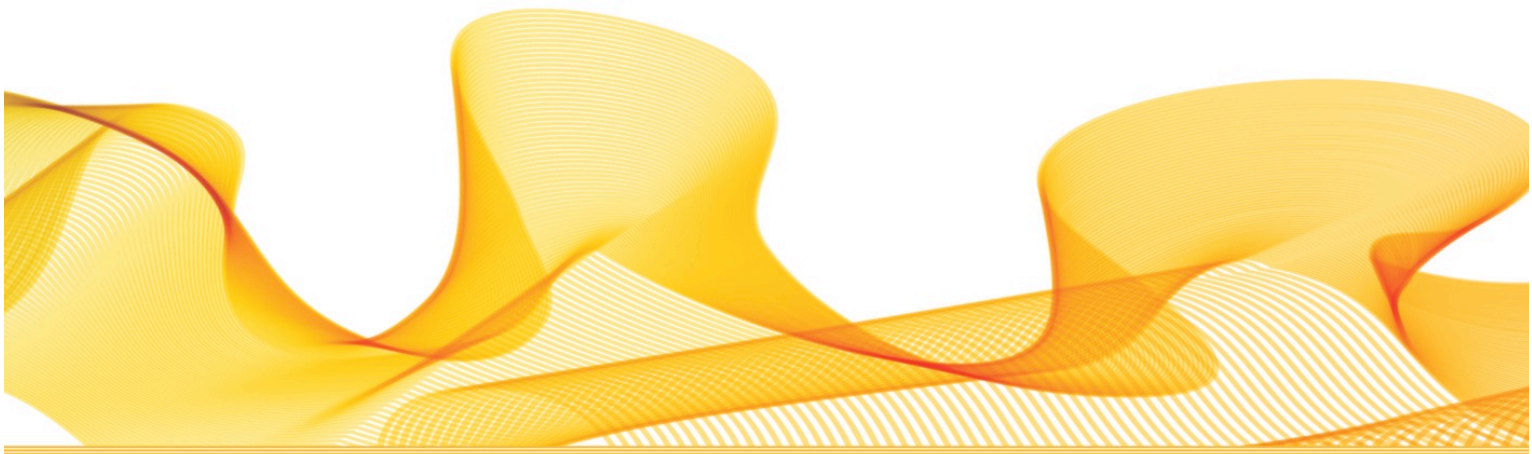
Aims
